POSTPONEMENT OF LABOUR COURT MATTER

Johannesburg 14 March 2014: Lawyers and counsel for the Chamber of Mines and the Association of Mineworkers and Construction Union (AMCU) have requested the Labour Court for a postponement of the return date on the matter originally set down for today, Friday, 14 March 2014. The new date set by the court is 5 June 2014.

The Labour Court issued a ruling on 30 January 2014 declaring a strike called by AMCU to be unprotected, on an interim basis, as it was not compatible with the requirements of the Labour Relations Act. The order interdicted the union from proceeding with the strike or encouraging its members from embarking on the strike.

The order will remain in place pending the new date.

The matter has been postponed to give the parties adequate time to prepare.
