GOLD WAGE NEGOTIATIONS UPDATE:

Negotiations to continue next week between producers and unions

Johannesburg, 17 July 2015: Gold wage negotiations between gold producers (AngloGold Ashanti, Evander Gold Mines, Harmony, Sibanye Gold and Village Main Reef) and unions (the Association of Mineworkers and Construction Union (AMCU), the National Union of Mineworkers (NUM), UASA and Solidarity) will continue next week.

The negotiations process will include bilateral meetings with each union to discuss union-specific issues following which the parties will reconvene.

Speaking on behalf of the Chamber of Mines, Dr Elize Strydom, said: “The producers will collectively engage the unions separately during the course of next week to further address the issues raised by each union.”
