GOLD WAGE NEGOTIATIONS UPDATE:

Gold wage negotiations continue - producers meet with AMCU

Johannesburg, 20 July 2015: Gold wage negotiations between gold producers (AngloGold Ashanti, Evander Gold Mines, Harmony, Sibanye Gold and Village Main Reef) and unions continued today. A series of bilateral meetings between the producers and each of the unions will be taking place in the coming week.

Speaking on behalf of the Chamber of Mines, Dr Elize Strydom, said: "Today we met with AMCU as part of the bilateral meeting process, with the companies engaging with the union on their specific demands. Discussions between the parties were constructive and we look forward to further engagement."

Dr Strydom reiterated that the companies were seeking to reach an agreement that would sustain the industry for decades to come, and with it jobs.
