GOLD WAGE NEGOTIATIONS UPDATE:

Johannesburg, 4 August 2015: Gold wage negotiations continued with the gold companies (AngloGold Ashanti, Harmony and Sibanye Gold) meeting with AMCU today.

While AMCU formally rejected the final offer tabled by companies on Thursday, 30 July, the unions has also indicated firmly that it wanted to engage further.

Speaking on behalf of the producers, Dr Elize Strydom said: “We are clearly disappointed that AMCU has not accepted our offers. Our offers were made after serious consideration and despite the worsening financial position of the industry. Whilst we are willing to continue to engage, we must reiterate that the quantum of our offer is final.”

The gold producers will meet with the NUM, Solidarity and UASA on Friday, 7 August.
